We collected 129.8kg in total, which the Foodbank acknowledged by sending us a certificate. A huge thank you to everyone across the school who donated.

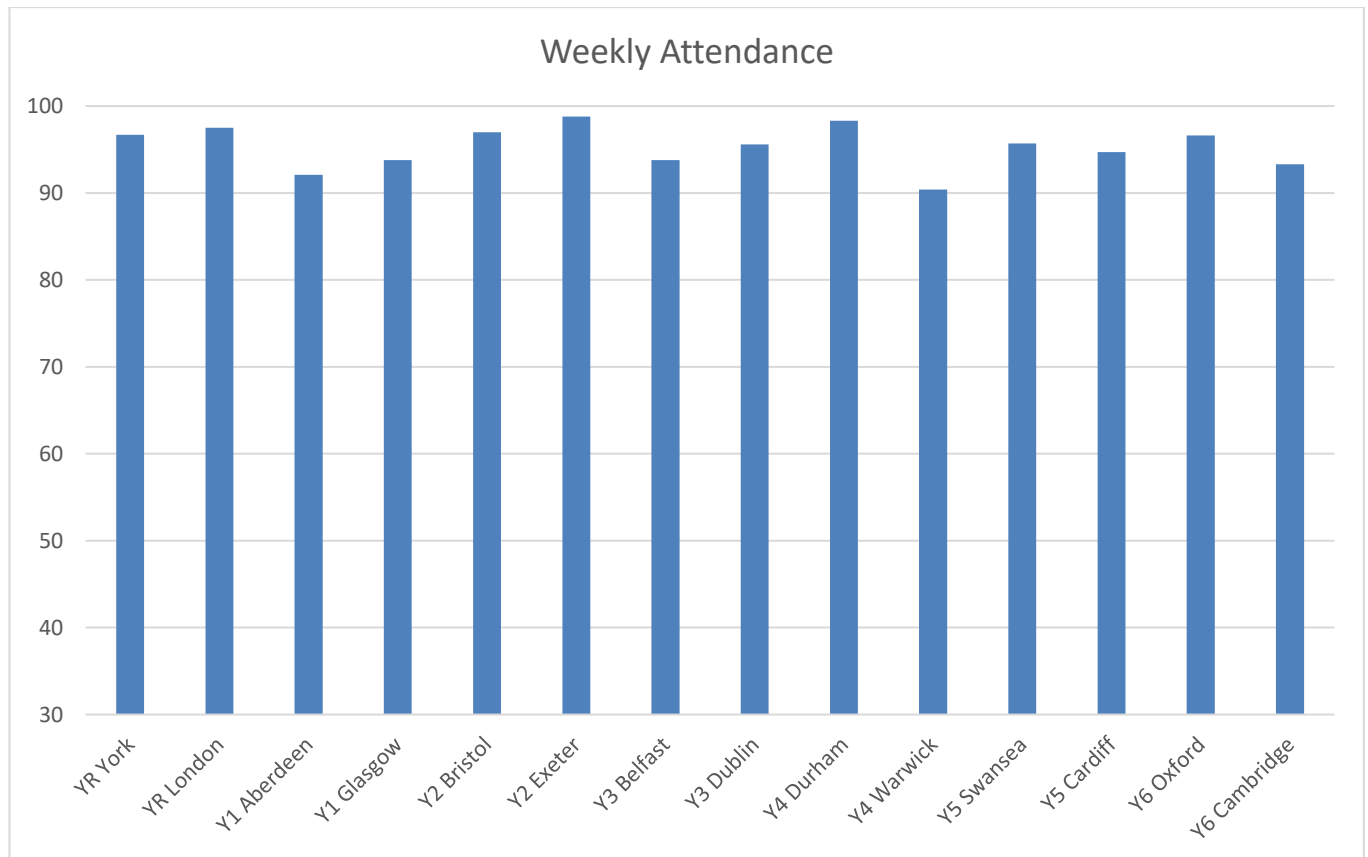
