

What will you choose to do?

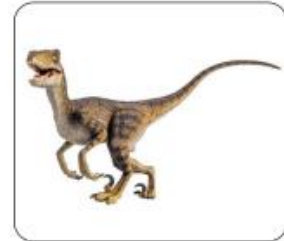

- Visit the [BBC Bitesize – Dinosaur Discovery website](#) and play the game. Write down a dinosaur fact that you found out when you played the game. Use phonics to help you write your sentence.
- Fossils are preserved bones or prints. Visit the [Natural History Museum – Discover Dinosaurs website](#) to find out more about fossils. Make salt dough by mixing 1 cup of plain flour, $\frac{1}{2}$ cup of salt and $\frac{1}{2}$ cup of water. Use the salt dough to make a dinosaur skeleton. Take a photograph of your dinosaur skeleton.
- When dinosaurs lived millions of years ago the world looked very different. Draw a dinosaur map that includes a volcano, swamp, forest, cave and a river. Label your map carefully.
