A plant is a living thing. A sunflower is a type of plant.



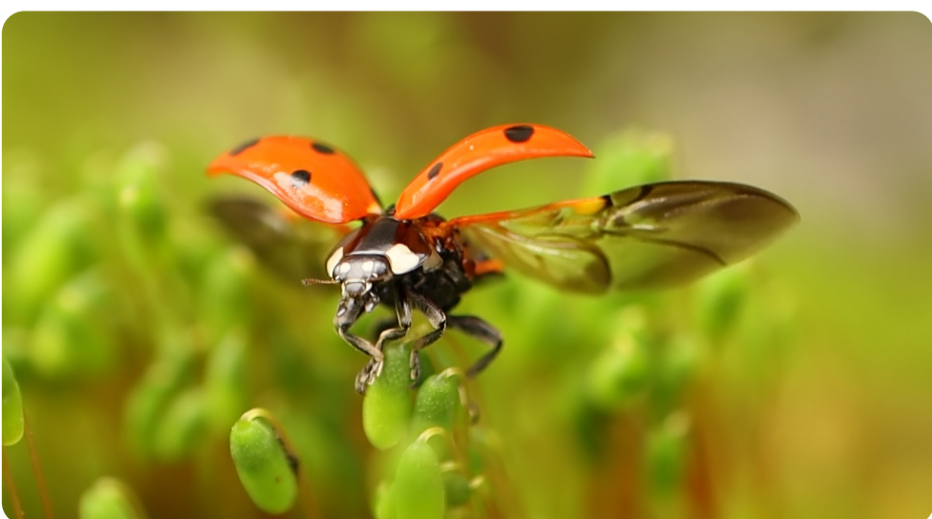
Plants need air, sunlight, warmth, water and nutrients from soil to grow.

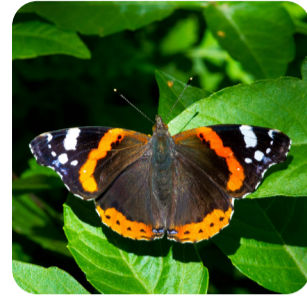
